The Washington Headquarters Services / Pentagon Renovation & Construction Program Office has been renovating and modernizing the Pentagon since 1991 when Congress transferred the building to the DoD. The Wedge 5 Demolition ceremonies marked the beginning of the final Wedge to be renovated. The construction activity will complete the historic renovation and modernization of the entire 6.5 million square foot interior of the Pentagon.
