

2008: A Year in Review

2008 saw many accomplishments and highlights for the Pentagon Renovation Program. A number of high-profile projects were completed, in addition to 2 awards:

- **CCY Café:** PENREN rebuilt the historic Center Courtyard Café into a year-round, all-weather facility, featuring restrooms and an indoor seating capacity of around 60. It was opened to the public in April 2008.
- **Pentagon Memorial:** PENREN managed the design and construction effort for the Pentagon Memorial. The Memorial commemorates the lives of 184 people lost at the Pentagon and onboard American Airlines Flight 77 on September 11, 2001. It was dedicated and opened to the public on September 11, 2008.
- **Wedge 4.1:** The first phase of Wedge 4 was complete in October 2008. Wedge 4.1 contains the first phase of the new concourse, including the Hall of Heroes, Pentagon Federal Credit Union, Post Office, and tenant moves of approximately 2,200 people into newly renovated areas.
- **LEED Certification:** On June 6, 2008, the Pentagon Library & Conference Center and Wedge 2 were awarded LEED Certification from the U.S. Green Building Council. The PLC2 is the first project to receive silver-level LEED certification.

New A-Ring Tunnel


A new A-ring tunnel connecting Corridor 1 and Corridor 10 on the 3rd floor will be open for use on December 8, 2008. The tunnel provides continuous access around the interior of the Pentagon while areas are under renovation. The current tunnel on the 2nd floor will also be open that week, but will be closed on December 12, 2008 at 7:00 p.m.
