Wedge 4.1 Completed

The first phase of Wedge 4 is now complete and open to the public. It is the first phase of the new concourse and also part of the new construction barrier route leading from the Metro Entrance Facility.

Looking ahead, upcoming relocations:

- Hall of Heroes
- Pentagon Federal Credit Union
- Post Office
- Tenant moves of approximately 2,200 people into newly renovated areas

FBI & PFFA Host Hate Crimes Presentation



On October 6, the FBI and PFFA hosted a hate crimes presentation for approximately 700 contractors and subcontractors on the Wedge 2-5 project.

- It was broken up into 4 meetings: the first 2 were in English, and the second 2 were in Spanish.
- During the approximately 15 minute presentation, they briefed on what a "hate crime" is by definition, and gave examples.
- Attendees were told to contact security if any gang symbols or any other indicator of a hate crime is noticed on the Reservation.
- Employees were briefed that if they were to become personally involved in a hate crime, at a minimum, they would be removed from site, and pending a thorough investigation, could face repercussions to the fullest extent of the law.
