**Section I. GENERAL**

**1. Purpose.** This regulation prescribes preparation of reports which will provide The Surgeon General with information required during peacetime for determining the adequacy and current status of the procurement of Medical, Dental, and certain Veterinary Corps officers and furnishes a basis for programming and selection. These reports will also enable the Department of the Army to carry out its assigned mission as Executive Agent for the Department of Defense for the administration of the Doctor Draft. In addition, these reports will be the basis for personnel planning during mobilization periods.

**2. Scope.** Reports will furnish information concerning—

a. Medical and Dental Corps officers ordered to or being processed for active duty.

b. Physicians and dentists who applied for participation in the Armed Forces Physicians' Appointment and Residency Consideration Program (Berry Plan), or the Armed Forces Reserve Dental Officer Commissioning Program (DOCP)

respectively (see AR 135-50), and those obligated for active duty under the Medical Service Early Commissioning Program (ECP). See AR 601-140.

c. All physicians, dentists, and veterinarians who have been ordered for induction by the Selective Service System until allocation has been made to the Departments of the Army, Navy, and Air Force.

d. Those physicians, dentists, and veterinarians who have been ordered for induction by the Selective Service System are allocated to the Department of the Army and are being processed under the provisions of AR 601-54.

e. The current status of the programmed input of future physicians, dentists and veterinarians by fiscal year in the Medical Service Early Commissioning Program. See AR 601-140.

**3. Preparing agencies.** The reports will be prepared by the Commanding Generals, ANTCOM USARSO, USARHAW, USARAL, and ZI armies.

These regulations supersede AR 601-142, 20 May 1963.

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## Section II. AMEDS PERSONNEL PROCUREMENT SUMMARY

(Reports Control Symbol MED-191) (R1)

**4. Form.** The report will be prepared and submitted on DA Form 2690-R (AMEDS Personnel Procurement Summary) (fig. 1). DA Form 2690-R will be reproduced locally on 8- x 13-inch paper. Letter of transmittal is not required.

**5. Frequency, routing, and due dates.** The report will be prepared for each month and will be dispatched in three copies to The Surgeon General, ATTN: MEDPT-MP, Department of the Army, Washington, D.C., 20315, not later than the 6th working day following the report period.

**6. Instructions for preparation.** *a. Section A—Active Duty Processing (other than for training).*

- (1) Columns b, c, and d will include the number of cases being processed for, or ordered to active duty, during the current fiscal year under the provisions of AR 135-50, and identified in accordance with AR 601-110.
- (2) Column e will include those individuals who are obligated for active duty under the Medical Service Early Commissioning Program, including ROTC. Do not include Berry Plan participants (AR 135-50), or regular and special registrants who are being ordered to active duty as commissioned officers after having been ordered for induction.
- (3) Column f will include only those cases which cannot be identified under any other columnar title or as directed by The Surgeon General.
- (4) Column g will include all volunteers for active duty, excluding Berry Plan participants (AR 135-50) and special registrants who have been ordered for induction. In addition to normal volunteer cases include regular registrants who have been ordered for induction.
- (5) Column h will be a total of all lines.

*b. Section B—Armed Forces Medical and Dental Reserve Program.*

- (1) Line 9 will include all physicians and dentists allocated for commissioning to the area commander or obligated for active duty during the fiscal year of the report

period. Those listed under ECP (columns k and m) should be the total shown in items 32 and 36 and will not be shown under Berry Plan or DOCP (columns j and l).

- (2) Line 16 will include all physicians and dentists who have been selected for deferment to complete residency training or other postgraduate activities. It should be increased by the number in the ECP from item 14 that will be further deferred or delayed under the Berry Plan or DOCP.
- (3) Line 23 includes personnel not selected for deferment, those to come to active duty immediately after internship or upon graduation from dental school, and physicians in delay status for 1 year after completion of internship and dentists delayed for internship only (items 24 through 29).
- (4) Line 25 will include only physicians and dentists who accepted commissions. Reported data will equal the sums of lines 30 and 31.
- (5) Line 30 will include physicians to be brought to active duty immediately upon completion of internship, and dentists to be brought to active duty immediately upon graduation from dental school.
- (6) Line 31 will include only physicians and dentists who accept commissions and will enter active duty one year after medical internship or immediately after dental internship.

*c. Section C—Medical Service Early Commissioning Program (including ROTC officers).*

- (1) Line 32 will include physicians in an internship obligated for active duty, who were graduates in the previous fiscal year, including ROTC participants.
- (2) Lines 33, 36, and 40 will include all current fiscal year appointments in the Medical Service Corps.
- (3) Lines 33 through 35, lines 37 and 39 and lines 41 through 43 will include future fiscal year data as outlined in (1) above.

### Section III. SPECIAL REGISTRANTS ORDERED FOR INDUCTION BY SELECTIVE SERVICE

#### (Reports Control Symbol MED-192)

**7. Form.** The report will be prepared and submitted on DA Form 2691-R (Special Registrants Ordered for Induction by Selective Service) (fig. 2). DA Form 2691-R will be reproduced locally on 8- x 10½-inch paper. Letter of transmittal is not required.

**8. Frequency, routing, and due dates.** *a.* Report will be used only when the Selective Service System has issued a special call for physicians, dentists, and/or veterinarians.

*b.* Preparing agencies will submit initial report as of 2400 hours on the first Monday following announcement by Headquarters, Department of the Army that such a call has been issued. The final report will be submitted pursuant to instructions from The Surgeon General.

*c.* The report will be prepared for each week as of 2400 hours on Monday and dispatched in three copies to The Surgeon General, ATTN: MEDPT-MP, no later than 2400 hours the following day.

**9. Instructions for preparation.** *a.* Line 1 will include the total number reported to the area commander by the Selective Service as having been ordered for induction. It will equal the sum of lines 2 through 6.

*b.* Line 2 will include those noted in line 1 whose cancellation of induction order has been reported to the area commander by the Selective Service System. They will be identified by name in the remarks section.

*c.* Lines 3 through 5 will include those reported in line 1 that have been called by Selective Service and who have been allocated to the Army, Navy, and Air Force, respectively, by the area commander. Line 3 will equal the sum of lines 7 and 12. Copies of allocation letters will accompany this report to The Surgeon General, ATTN: MEDPT-MP.

*d.* Line 6 will be utilized only when a special call is being implemented for two or three military services and will include those special registrants included in line 1 who have not yet been allocated to any of the military departments.

*e.* Lines 7 through 13 will include only special registrants reported as allocated to Army (line 3).

- (1) Line 7 will include those nominated by the area commander to The Surgeon General for assignment instructions. It will equal the sum of lines 8, 9, 10 and 11. Lines 9 and 10 are included, since nomination must occur prior to delay or deferment action.
  - (2) Line 8 will include those for whom the area commander has received duty assignment instructions from The Surgeon General.
  - (3) Line 9 will include those for whom the area commander has received duty assignment instructions, and who have an application for delay or deferment under the provisions of AR 601-25 and AR 601-134. Only individuals for whom duty assignments have been received may be processed for delay or deferment under the provisions of this regulation.
  - (4) Line 10 will include those who have been delayed or deferred under the provisions of AR 601-25 and AR 601-134. They will be identified by name in the remarks section with date of availability indicated.
  - (5) Line 11 will include those nominated to The Surgeon General for whom the area commander has not received assignment instructions.
  - (6) Line 12 will include those who have not been nominated to The Surgeon General for active duty. Those who will not be nominated to The Surgeon General will be shown in parentheses with explanation in the remarks section.
  - (7) Line 13 will include those who, in the opinion of the area commander, will be nominated to The Surgeon General within 15 days from the end of the report period.
- f.* The remarks section will be used to clarify any portion of the report and will be continued on the reverse side, if necessary.


