**TRANSMISSION OF RECRUITING INFORMATION TO INDIVIDUALS
IN FOREIGN COUNTRIES**

1. Policy. The sending of recruitment information and material into a foreign country to other than American diplomatic officials without the consent of the foreign nation involved is prohibited, regardless of the channel of communication used. (Former enemy territory occupied by the U.S. Armed Forces is not considered as a "foreign country.")

The sending of recruitment information into a foreign country to other than American diplomatic officials without the consent of the foreign nation involved is prohibited, regardless of the channel of communication used. However, for your guidance in this matter, enlistments in the U.S. Army are restricted to U.S. citizens and those non-citizens who have been admitted to the United States for permanent residence.

2. Replies to inquiries. When inquiries are received that require the transmission of recruitment information to individuals in foreign countries, the inquirer will be advised substantially as follows:

In view of the above policy, I regret that I can give you no further information regarding service in the U.S. Army.

Reference is made to your recent letter relative to service in the U.S. Army.

3. Aliens applying in person at recruiting stations in the United States or its possessions. Paragraph 2 does not apply to aliens who apply in person at recruiting stations in the United States or its possessions. Such persons will be informed of the enlistment requirements and opportunities offered by the U.S. Army.
