PERSONNEL IDENTIFICATION

ISSUE OF IDENTIFICATION CARDS IN THE
WASHINGTON AREA

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1. Purpose. This regulation establishes responsibility for issue in the Washington area of the identification cards provided for in AR 606-5.

2. Issuing agency. a. The Commanding Officer, U.S. Army Photographic Agency, Room 1B877, The Pentagon, is delegated authority to issue the identification cards provided for in AR 606-5 within the Military District of Washington, except as provided in b below.

b. The Commanding Generals, Fort Belvoir, U.S. Army Security Agency, and Walter Reed Army Medical Center, will issue the identification cards prescribed in AR 606-5 to military personnel and their dependents and civilian personnel of their installations.

3. Procedure. a. Application, issue, loss, surrender, disposition, supply of blank forms, material and equipment, and accountability will be accomplished in accordance with AR 606-5 and supplementary instructions in this regulation.

b. Offices, agencies, or activities of assignment or employment of military personnel and civilian employees will—

- (1) Execute DA Form 428 (Application for Identification Card), obtaining signature of the applicant and affixing signature of approving authority.
- (2) Furnish DD Form 577 (Signature Card) to issuing agency for use in verifying signatures of the approving authority.
- (3) Furnish issuing agency DD Form 577 bearing messenger's signature if bulk pickup is desired. Inform messenger to sign DA Form 428 for each card.
- (4) Inform applicant his card may be picked up from the issuing agency by signing DA Form 428 and surrendering card being replaced, if any.

c. Dependents residing within the Washington area who are eligible for medical care, commissary, post exchange, or theater privileges may in person submit DD Form 1172 (Application for Uniformed Services Identification and Privilege Card), in duplicate, to the Administrative Service Branch, U.S. Army Service Center for the Armed Forces, MDW, Room 1A860, The Pentagon. DD Form 1172 must be verified under the provisions of AR 606-5 or contain supporting documentation to establish eligibility for DD Form 1173 (Uniformed Services Identification and Privilege Card).

d. Civilian employees of agencies outside the Department of Defense and other eligible civilians proceeding under orders issued by the Office, Secretary

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of Defense, or the Department of the Army may submit DA Form 428, provided that copies of such orders and appropriate identification are furnished. DA Form 428 need not be authenticated by the Department of the Army in this case. DA Forms 428 submitted by such personnel, when not accompanied by Office, Secretary of Defense or Department of the Army orders will be forwarded to The Adjutant General for authentication, under the cover of an official letter from the agency concerned.
