McCain Strategic Defense Fellowship Program is a 1-year Department of Defense (DoD) development program for recent advanced degree program graduates from across multiple academic disciplines. In accordance with the National Defense Authorization Act of Fiscal Year 2019, this program provides the DoD Components with the ability to recruit and develop future leaders from across the United States. Fellows are provided with challenging developmental opportunities and flourish into problem solvers, strategic thinkers, and future leaders. The Program instills a spirit of public service and a commitment to the larger DoD community.




What Will You Give as a Fellow?

What Will You Gain as a Fellow?



Beyond salary and benefits, the John S. McCain Strategic Defense Fellows Program provides valuable return on investment for a Fellow's commitment and hard work. A Fellow's one-year appointment provides a fast-paced opportunity to gain experience and develop. In addition to working as designed employee of a Department of Defense headquarters staff, Fellows will have the opportunity to participate in developmental activities as identified by their Sponsoring Components.

Key Fellowship Benefits:


- A full-time job with salary and benefits

- Incentives
 - **Relocation Incentive:** Up to \$5,000 if relocating to the National Capital Region (NCR) to participate in the program and up to \$5,000 if relocation outside of the NCR is required for post-fellowship placement within DoD
 - Student Loan Repayment Incentive: Up to \$10,000.
 - **Professional Development Training Incentive:** Up to \$5,000 during the 12-month fellowship.



Where Can Your McCain Fellowship Experience Take You?



Part springboard and part training ground; the McCain Fellowship experience is foundational and can take you anywhere you want to go with your career. While the John S. McCain Strategic Defense Fellowship Program is relatively young, many alumni have continued their Federal service within the Department of Defense. Others have leveraged the opportunity to land positions in other Federal agencies, the private sector, academia, and the non-profit world.







Application Requirements & How to Apply



Key Applicant Information

- Applicants must be recent graduates or soon to be graduates. An advanced degree must have been earned no earlier than two (2) years of a Fellow's appointment date.
- Applicants are evaluated on their technical and professional excellence, character, commitment to public service and academic achievement.
- The Cohort 6 application period will be open in Spring 2025.

Application Package:

- Resume
- Two letters of recommendation (from previous employers, professors, coaches, etc.)
- An endorsement letter or recommendation letter from the applicant's graduate institution
- Unofficial transcripts of educational achievement at the undergraduate and graduate levels
- An academic writing sample (i.e., published article, dissertation, thesis, etc.)
- A compelling narrative
